### Checks for play equipment:

- 'Free of broken, damaged, loose or missing parts
- Moving parts in good condition and without visible wear, including ropes/chains/links
- All components (wood, metal, plastic, etc) free of rust, rot, cracks, splits, splinters or breaks) – check all areas, including point of contact with ground
- Equipment anchoring stable, hardware secure
- All surfaces of equipment look clean

### Remedial works needed?

- 0=good condition
- 1= satisfactory
- 2=low level fault, fix or monitor
- 3=works needed for aesthetics or functionality
- 4= works needed for safety
- 5= unsafe – close the piece of equipment
